Your letter dated March 28, 2018, requesting cancellation of Outer Continental Shelf (OCS) Mineral Lessee's or Operator's Supplemental Bond No. SUR0035010, in the amount of \$1,750,000 was received by our office on March 28, 2018. This bond, conditioned to cover Right-of-Use and Easement OCS-G 30214, was executed on September 9, 2015, with Tarpon Operating & Development, L.L.C. as principal and Argonaut Insurance Company as surety.
