Your letter dated December 3, 2018, submitting your Increase Bond Rider, to be attached to and form a part of Outer Continental Shelf (OCS) Mineral Lessee's or Operator's Supplemental Bond No. SUR0032500, in the amount of \$2,435,000, was received by our office on December 4, 2018. This bond, conditioned to cover Right-of-Way OCS-G 29263, was executed on June 30, 2015, with Grand Isle Corridor, LP as principal and Argonaut Insurance Company as surety.

Attached to and forming a part of Bond No. SUR0032500, is Bond Increase Rider, executed on July 21, 2016, which increases the Bond amount by \$1,745,000 for a total penal sum of \$4,180,000. The rider is effective July 21, 2016.

Attached to and forming a part of Bond No. SUR0032500, is Bond Increase Rider, executed on August 20, 2018, which increases the Bond amount by \$2,354,000 for a total penal sum of \$6,534,000. The rider is effective March 28, 2018.

The Increase Bond Rider was executed on November 26, 2018 and increases Bond No. SUR0032500 by \$5, for a total penal sum of \$6,534,005. The rider is effective June 30, 2015, and has been attached to and now forms a part of the original bond.

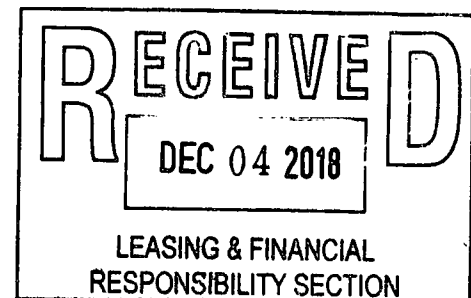

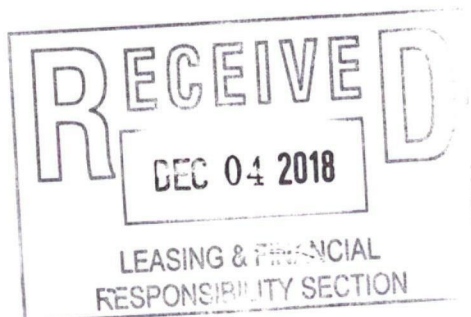
