

EPL Oil & Gas, Inc. (GOM No. 2266) seeks to update its qualification with BOEM to reflect its conversion from a Delaware corporation to a Delaware limited liability company named EPL Oil & Gas, LLC (the "Company"), effective December 31, 2018. Accordingly, we enclose the following documentation:
