Dear Mr. Lauer:

Your letter dated February 1, 2021, requesting cancellation of liability of Outer Continental Shelf (OCS) Right-of-Way Grant Bond No. 104104171, in the amount of \$300,000, was received by our office on February 2, 2021. This bond, conditioned to cover principal's pipeline operations in the Gulf of Mexico, was executed on August 28, 2003, with Samson Contour Energy E&P, LLC as principal and Travelers Casualty and Surety Company of America as surety.

Pursuant to 30 CFR 556.906 (d)(1) your bond may be cancelled seven years after the termination of the lease, six years after completion of all bonded obligations, or at the conclusion of any appeals or litigation related to your bonded obligation, whichever is the latest. The period of liability of Bond 104104171 was terminated January 31, 2014.

The Bureau of Ocean Energy Management has no objection to cancellation of the above bond. Therefore, Bond No. 104104171 is considered cancelled without residual liability, effective February 17, 2021, the date of final concurrence with such cancellation.
