You are hereby notified that the approval of the subject plan has been granted as of July 12, 2005, in accordance with 30 CFR 250.203(i)(1).

This approval includes the activities proposed for Well F.

Exercise caution while drilling due to indications of possible moderate water flow.

In response to the request accompanying your plan for a hydrogen sulfide ( $\rm H_2S$ ) classification, the area in which the proposed drilling operations are to be conducted is hereby classified, in accordance with 30 CFR 250.490(c), as " $\rm H_2S$  absent."

In accordance with Notice to Lessees and Operators (NTL) No. 2003-G03, the Minerals Management Service has determined that you will not need to conduct the two Remotely Operated Vehicle surveys you proposed in your plan.

Our review indicates that there are pipelines in the vicinity of Well F that may pose a hazard to your proposed operations. Therefore, take precautions in accordance with NTL No. 98-20, Section IV.B, prior to performing operations.

Within 15 days after the proposed well is completed and logged, submit a revision to your plan consisting of the information required for a Conservation Information Document in accordance with NTL 2000-N05.
