Reference is made to LLOG Exploration Offshore, LLC's (LLOG) Right-of-way (ROW) decommissioning application dated March 21, 2019, and received by this office on March 22, 2019, for Pipeline Segment Numbers (PSN) 17304 and 19041, ROW No. OCS-G28410. This application was amended with supplemental data via email dated and received by this office on March 27, 2019.

Specifically, LLOG requests to decommission PSNs 17304 and 19041 in-place.

The table below describes the pipeline segments pertaining to the aforementioned application:

Pursuant to 30 CFR 250.1751, LLOG's request to decommission PSNs 17304 and 19041 inplace is hereby approved. As a reminder, pursuant to 30 CFR 250.1754, if at any time the Regional Supervisor determines that the pipeline decommissioned in-place is an obstruction, it must be removed.

Approval to decommission PSNs 17304 and 19041 is subject to the United States Army Corps of Engineers (USACE) granting a concurrent approval for the aforementioned decommissioning operations. Therefore, LLOG must secure USACE permission to decommission the subject pipeline segments and provide documentation of said permission to BSEE within 180 days of USACE approval or within 180 days of the date of this letter. If LLOG is unable to secure USACE permission, the BSEE approval to decommission PSNs 17304 and 19041 in-place is revoked and LLOG must submit to BSEE for approved a revised decommissioning application to decommission the entire length of PSNs 17304 and 19041 that traverses the fairway/anchorage area and the spans of the subject pipeline segments a distance of 500 feet beyond both edges of the fairway/anchorage area boundary must be removed in accordance with 30 CFR 250.1752.

This office's records show that a cessation of operations to maintain ROW No. OCS-G28410 was not requested within 90 days of PSNs 17304 and 19041 out-of-service date on November 26, 2018. Therefore, pursuant to 30 CFR 250.1014, the ROW grant associated with ROW No. OCS-G28410 is deemed to have expired effective February 24, 2019.

Additionally, LLOG must cease transporting hydrocarbons through the subject pipeline segments immediately and complete the aforementioned decommissioning operations within 180 days of the date of this letter. As a reminder, pursuant to 30 CFR 250.1753, LLOG must submit a report to this office within 30 days after the completion of the aforementioned decommissioning operations.
