- ___ 9. Please provide status of ROW OCS-G _____, our records indicate that PSN _____ has been placed out of service _____. Therefore, Right of Way may have expired 90 days from the last flow date, since a cessation of operations request has not been submitted or pending.
- ___ 10. The ROW Assignment submitted by third party firm _____ is not registered nor recognized by BOEM's qualification card filings. Please verify information with BOEM's Land Law Examiners.
- ___ 11. Missing set of originals; please resubmit package including three original sets.
