Ladies and Gentlemen:


Please be advised Hoactzin Partners, L.P. (Hoactzin) placed the subject pipeline out-of-service on January 15, 2018.

Hoactzin understands the right-of-way grant has terminated.

Hoactzin respectfully requests a departure through October 31, 2020, from 30 CFR 250.1725(a) to remove pipeline segment no. 19050 within 1 year after the pipeline right-of-way terminates. Originally, Hoactzin had determined the pipeline had future utility; but, due to a recent tariff hike, the field has been determined to be uneconomical. The extension will allow for submittal of the decommissioning application, BSEE approval, contracting of the operations, and decommissioning operations.
