

Dear Ms. Powell:

By letter dated March 8, 2019, EnVen Energy Ventures, LLC (EnVen) requests withdrawal of the Suspension of Production (SOP) that the Bureau of Safety and Environmental Enforcement (BSEE) approved on January 16, 2019, for Lease OCS-G 32112 (the Lease), West Cameron Block 265. The January 16 SOP was scheduled to hold the Lease through August 31, 2019.

BSEE approved the January 16 SOP based on statements from EnVen indicating that it had a firm commitment to production. According to your March 8 letter, however, EnVen is no longer committed to production from the Lease.

The conditions under which your current SOP was granted on Lease OCS-G 32112 no longer exist. Therefore, pursuant to 30 CFR 250.170(e), the SOP is terminated effective March 15, 2019.
