Dear Mr. Parkman:

By letter dated July 30, 2020, amended letter submitted August 24, 2020, and supplemental information submitted September 17, 2020, EC Offshore Properties, Inc. (ECOP) requests a Suspension of Production (SOP) for Lease OCS-G 13576, East Cameron (EC) Block 71. This lease was held by operations, pursuant to 30 CFR 250.180, through August 1, 2020.

ECOP states that, due to multiple factors related to the COVID-19 pandemic, the time to complete negotiations for transportation agreements and design, refurbish, modify, and install equipment needed to commence production has lengthened. ECOP requests an SOP to complete activities needed to develop proven reserves on Lease OCS-G 13576 and plans to commence production by August 2021.

An SOP for Lease OCS-G 13576 is hereby approved, pursuant to 30 CFR 250.174(a), from August 2, 2020, through April 30, 2021. ECOP, or any subsequent operator, is expected to notify this office in writing (progress report) by the end of each month that a deadline is scheduled.
