

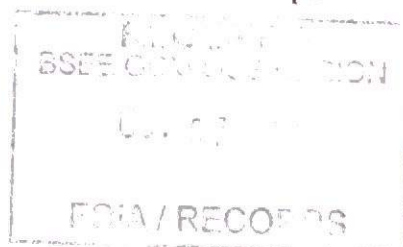

By letter dated February 11, 2022, and technical data provided April 5, 2022, Chevron U.S.A. Inc. (Chevron) requests approval of the Mississippi Canyon (MC) Block 607 Unit. A final executed copy of the Unit Agreement, the Unit Operating Agreement, and the initial plan of operation were received on August 5, 2022. The proposed unit area consists of portions of MC Blocks 607 and 651, Leases OCS-G 34451 and 34454, respectively.

We agree that the area is logically subject to unitization and the formation of this unit will promote and expedite exploration and development, in accordance with 30 CFR 250.1301. The executed Unit Agreement is hereby approved effective June 1, 2022, and has been assigned Unit Agreement No. 754322005. The initial plan of operations is approved from June 1, 2022, through May 31, 2023. Subsequent plans of operations shall be submitted in the manner prescribed in Article IX of the Unit Agreement.
