By letter dated May 22, 2022, with additional information submitted July 19, 2022, Shell Offshore Inc. requests approval of revised Exhibits A and B to the Mississippi Canyon Block 392 Unit Agreement, No. 754312009. The unit consists of portions of Leases OCS-G 26252 and 26253, from depths below 16,500 feet SSTVD down to 50,000 feet SSTVD. The revised exhibits reflect the change in the unit area resulting from the implementation of the contraction provision contained in Article 13 of the Unit Agreement. This contraction provision was effective on May 22, 2022.
