Dear Ms. Rachal:

Your letter dated June 2, 2011, with additional information received in an e-mail dated June 6, 2011, requests a Suspension of Production (SOP) for Lease OCS-G 22939, Green Canyon Block 300. This lease is in its primary term and will expire on June 30, 2011.

Lease OCS-G 22939, Well No. 2 was drilled and temporarily abandoned on September 25, 2006. The petrophysical examination completed on January 12, 2007, determined that Well No. 2 is producible in accordance with 30 CFR 250.116. ATP Oil & Gas Corporation (ATP) has a rig under contract that will move to this location upon completion of its current operation. After completion and tie-back, production is scheduled to commence by the end of March 2012.

An SOP for Lease OCS-G 22939 is hereby approved, pursuant to 30 CFR 250.174(a), from July 1 through August 31, 2011. ATP, or any subsequent operator, is expected to follow the enclosed activity schedule and to notify this office in writing (progress report) by the end of each month that a deadline is scheduled.
